


How to edit the text on your page

From here, you can personalise your page. When you hover over a section, you'll notice that you can edit it. When you see an purple border, that means you're about to edit a section.

See the purple box around the black text in the image below.

From here you can edit the bolded heading and the text on your fundraising page.

Your page is publicly viewable, so please keep that in mind when sharing personal information such as the location of your feast.
